Christine Tatum is a veteran writer and editor who has worked for the Chicago Tribune, The Denver Post and the (Greensboro, N.C.) News & Record. As mentor and teacher of Journalism, Shishir co-curated a first-of-its-kind teaching programme in Citizen Journalism and mentored over 700 citizen journalists across several states in India. He is currently the CEO of Bombay First, a not-for-profit Public Private Partnership.
