Thus ignited an adventure fueled by curiosity, driving Ahtushi to delve deeper into the mysterious petroglyphs scattered across Ladakh. Over a decade, she meticulously documented these ancient artworks, racing against time as many vanished

before her lens, preserved only within the pages of her book. Ahtushi's unparalleled photo documentation spans Ladakh's highest passes to its coldest, scarcely inhabited regions.
